Gloria Wooding will attend national Episcopal Cursillo Seminar, Daytona, FL on October 23-26, 2008.

It was announced that ECUSA has become The Episcopal Church (TEC).

As the meeting moved into agenda, it was specifically agreed that confidentiality be observed, and to remember the focus of Cursillo is to create laity leadership in the church.

There was discussion on Non-Episcopalian team members and candidates. A participant must be baptized member in good standing of the Episcopal Church (TEC) or the Evangelical Lutheran Church.

2008 Weekends:

East Slope, August 29 - September 1 at Highlands Presbyterian Camp and Retreat Center, Allenspark, CO. A deposit of \$2953.75 is due by March 5, 2008. It was agreed to accept contract. Theme to be "Lord, Reign on Me".

West Slope. It was agreed not to proceed on a May 2008 date, to leave open-ended. The decision was based on need for better preparation, sponsor training, development of clergy and parish relations, and consideration of alternate locations.

Minimum Number of Candidates to Hold a Weekend. Given that the responsibility of the Rector is to cover expenses, it was agreed a weekend should break even and not be based on a specific number of candidates.
